Springfield area.

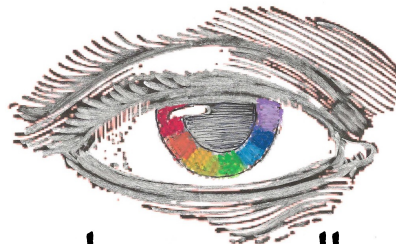

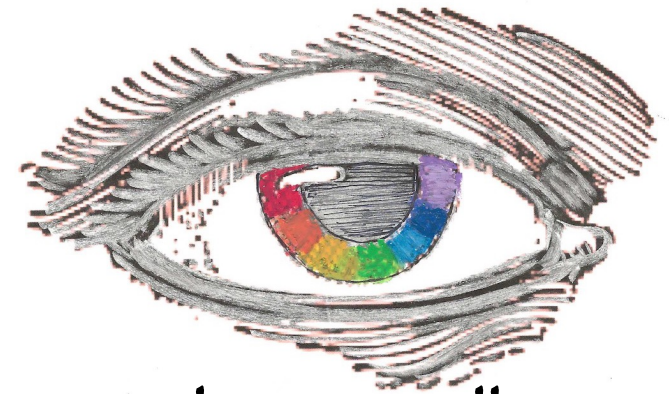

MEMBERSHIP, MEETINGS & EXHIBITS

Membership:

Membership is non-exclusive so members are free to exhibit and sell outside the Alliance. Dues are assessed on an annual calendar basis. Current dues must be paid to participate in any exhibition.

Meetings:

Monthly meetings are *typically* on the FIRST Thursday of the month at Juanita K. Hammons Hall for the Performing Arts, 525 S JQH Blvd. A meeting and presentation, speaker or demonstration are offered. Changes are posted on the website or sent via an emailed newsletter.

Accepted Media:

Members are welcome to enter: Acrylics, digital (non-AI), drawing, fiber, mixed media, oils, pastels, photography, watercolors, and 3-D (as compatible with venue).

Ongoing Exhibits:

Juried exhibits are hung at Juanita K. Hammons Hall for the Performing Arts on the 5th floor throughout the year with a variety of themes. Featured member artists are hung on the 4th floor during the same times.

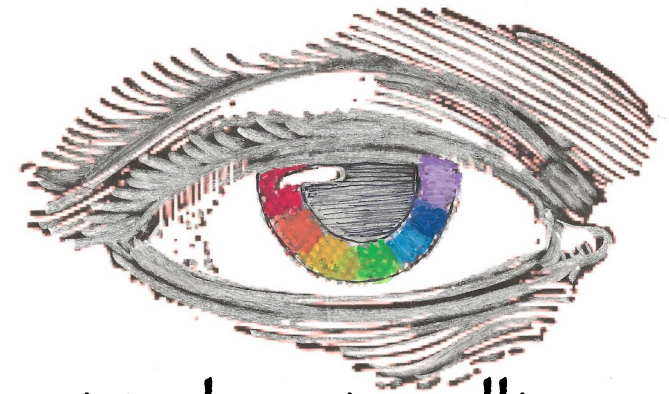
Prize money is awarded at each juried show and may include Best of Show, Best Expression of Theme, Honorable Mention, and other individual awards.
